

Leaf Collection vs. Yard Waste Collection

Did you know that leaf collection and yard waste collection done by the Borough are different types of pickups? Here is a quick guide outlining the differences between the two!

Leaf Collection

- Runs from October 15, 2019 until December 31, 2019
- Collects leaves ONLY where trash is picked up
- Is weather permitting
- Can be collected in biodegradable bags or with a machine depending on your address (see inside for machine pickup locations)

Yard Waste Collection

- Runs from April through October each year
- Can be collected in biodegradable bags OR yard waste totes
- Can include:
 - sticks
 - leaves
 - garden waste
 - grass clippings/weeds

Remaining 2019 Yard Waste Pickup Weeks:

Week of October 14th

Week of October 28th

After these dates yard waste can always be brought to the compost site

Christmas Tree Disposal

December 26th to March 1st

Live Trees Only!

Curbside Pickup: Leave outside with your regular trash

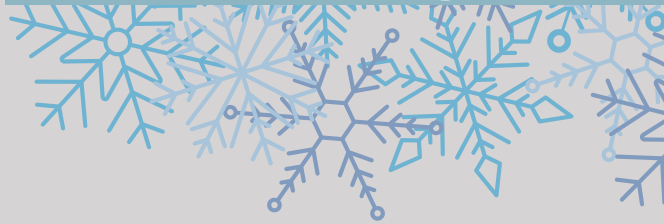
Compost: Residents can take their trees to the compost site at 18 S 2nd Ave.

Tree must be free of ornaments, and cannot be in a base!

Snow Emergency



What do I do during a snow emergency?

In the event that a snow emergency is declared, an official declaration will be made by the Mayor. The announcement will be posted on the Borough's website, shared via the Borough's social media pages, and an alert will be pushed out through the Alert Center. Please follow and subscribe to these platforms to stay informed about possible snow emergencies by visiting our website and look for the "Notify Me" button on the left side of the homepage.

When a snow emergency is declared, vehicles are to be removed from snow emergency routes prior to the time that the snow emergency takes effect. Removing cars from the route allows the plows to clear the roads for emergency travel.

Bridge Street	From Pothouse Road to Schuylkill River
Church Street	From Bridge Street to Starr Street
Dayton Street	From Emmett Street to Freemont Street
Emmett Street	From Franklin Avenue to Dayton Street
Franklin Avenue	From Gay Street to Emmett Street
Gay Street	From South Borough boundary to Franklin Ave.
Main Street (Rte. 29)	From South Borough boundary to Nutt Road
Main Street	From Nutt Road to Bridge Street
Manavon Street	From Nutt Road to Starr Street
Nutt Road	From East Borough boundary to West Borough boundary
Starr Street	From Nutt Road to Bridge Street

2019 Leaf Collection

The 2019 leaf collection season will begin
October 15th and will end
December 31st.

Sections A and B residents will have their leaves collected on a continuous schedule, meaning that there is no specific leaf pickup day for these sections. Section C residents will have their leaves picked up on Fridays.

This means your street will be picked up about one time in seven working days.

Properties on the following streets will have their leaves picked up by vacuum truck. If your street is not listed, you must bag your leaves in biodegradable paper bags with your address written on them and place them out for leaf collection.

Leaf collection pickup is contingent upon weather conditions. Please be patient with us!

Did you know you can also bring your bags of leaves to the Borough compost site at 18 S 2nd Ave.?
