


Community Values Survey - Consensus Issues

Public Visioning Workshop - Highlights

LAND USE

- Clarify decision making and involve the public
- Address traffic congestion
- Greater variety of businesses in downtown Phoenixville
- Sustain and improve agriculture
- Enhance retail and office space
- Zone for mixed-use villages

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Support adaptive reuse of “big-box” properties
- Support creative/innovative industries
- Revitalize and provide tax incentives for redevelopment of abandoned properties

COMMUNITY FACILITIES

- Pedestrian connections/linkages via sidewalks and walking paths
- Public water and sewer systems provided to underserved populations
- Community solar/renewable energy opportunities

ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES

- Quality of water resources
- Reforestation
- More extensive mapping of contamination and degradation sites

HOUSING

- Cost of housing and its relation to employment
- Zoning that allows for affordable housing
- Connect to Phoenixville Task Force

Public Visioning Workshop - Highlights

RECREATION RESOURCES

- Trail connections
- Expand park and play structures in the Borough
- Mechanism for municipal purchase of open space
- Natural materials for trail surfaces

TRANSPORTATION

- Relief of traffic congestion
- Parking in the Borough/Downtown parking garage
- Commuter rail
- Addition to and adaptation of existing trails

HISTORIC RESOURCES

- Adequate access (i.e. parking) for historic resources
- Education initiative for historic property homeowners
- Support historic institutions
- Events to highlight Region's history and culture

QUALITY OF LIFE

- Recognize changing demographics/celebrate community diversity
- Promote unique offerings of the region:
 - Farmer's Market
 - The Canal
 - The Health Foundation
 - Colonial Theater
 - First Fridays
 - Iron and Steel Tour
 - Duck Race
- Detriments to quality of life:
 - Lack of public transportation
 - Lack of connection with fellow residents
 - Housing costs
